

Camp Hermosa Site Plan Notes

Changes to the Camp Hermosa site are being considered. More space is needed for program staff and volunteers for overnight accommodation and for equipment storage. It is suggested that new cabins be constructed for campers, with some of the existing cabins removed or reused for other uses.

Boys Side

- Cabins 7 & 8 remain – repurposed as cabins for volunteer accommodation
- New boy cabins in front of existing cabins – rotated 90 degrees (lengthwise E-W) (4 total)
- Re-route road on west (cliff) side of new cabins

Girls Side

- New cabins built slightly south of existing cabins (7 total)
- New cabin 1 to be used as an overflow cabin for either boys or girls (near the present cabin 1)

Front Triplex Area

- Remove front staff triplex & missionary cabin
- Move 4 old camper cabins & renovate
 - o 3 for staff (2/cabin – 6 total) – permanent dividing wall
 - o 1 for volunteers – no permanent division – leave open for different configurations

Back Triplex Area

- Remove back triplex
- Move old camper cabin along tree line for storage of bicycles and archery equipment
- Construct new maintenance & tractor shed (single building) in area of existing staff cabin
- Construct laneway running from south side of dining lodge to new shed

Shower Building

- Proposed addition – expand to west – reconfigure as boys only shower, plus one unisex handicap-accessible washroom & shower (separate entrance)

Girls Washroom

- Reconfiguration – add showers for girls
- Tear down structure, use existing footprint & change/expand layout as necessary
- 1 unisex handicap accessible washroom & shower

Other

- Separate building used as staff lounge and tuck shop, located to north of Nurse's cabin
- Existing laneway into camp would end at south end of Norman Dabbs Lodge (currently extends to Nurse's cabin)
- Area around south end of ND Lodge (by sandbox) would become parking area to allow for registration to continue to take place inside ND Lodge. Children's sandbox and playground equipment would be moved near pool.
